HOWLING CALE ALE€4.50
 | 5.0% a.b.v. | Cork, Ireland
 This is a refreshing pale ale hopped with American Chinook, Amarillo & Centennial hops. It is categorised by a moderate hop bitterness well balanced with slight biscuit & caramel pale malt body.

SUNBURNT IRISH RED€4.50
 | 5.0% a.b.v. | Cork, Ireland
 The Sunburnt Irish Red takes the characteristic sweet caramel malt & burnt roasted barley of an Irish Red Ale and adds additional malt complexity by using six different malts. The malt body is counter balanced with Australian and New Zealand hops, adding a modern twist to the traditional style.

CARRIG CRAFT IRISH LAGER€5.00
 | 4.3% a.b.v. | Offaly, Ireland
 Carrig lager pours to a golden pale colour and has a clean, crisp, full bodied taste. Consistent & sufficient fermentation gives Carrig a pleasantly smooth taste with a thirst quenching finish.

GALWAY HOOKER I.P.A.€5.00
 | 4.4% a.b.v. | Roscommon, Ireland
 Galway Hooker initially greets the palate with a balanced burst of tangy bitterness and understated biscuity flavours which perfectly compliment the floral aroma & citrusy, dry finish.

O'HARA'S IRISH PALE ALE€5.00
 | 5.2% a.b.v. | Carlow, Ireland
 This is a contemporary style I.P.A. Grapefruit like bitterness is full and lasting and is balanced by a zesty citrus aroma. Voted Best Beer 2010 by the members of Irish Craft Brewer.com

O'HARA'S CURIM WHEAT BEER€5.00
 | 4.3% a.b.v. | Carlow, Ireland
 Delightfully refreshing wheat beer brewed using a blend of malted barley and wheat. It is lightly hopped resulting in a fruity beer with hints of peach, banana and plum.

HOEGAARDEN€5.00
 | 4.9% a.b.v. | Hoegaarden, Belgium
 The original Belgian White - a light, refreshing wheat. The beer is very pale, lighter in color than Pilsner, and cloudy. The cloudiness contributes whiteness to the appearance, thus the name. Great summer ale.

5A.M. SAINT€4.50
 | 5% a.b.v. | Fraserburgh, Scotland
 The have dry-hopped this little beauty to the brink and back with the help of amarillo and centennial hops that create an all out riot of citrus, orange and lychee flavours.

HARDCORE IPA€5.00
 | 9.2% a.b.v. | Fraserburgh, Scotland
 This explicit ale has more hops and bitterness than any other beer brewed in the UK, fact. This is an extreme beer rollercoaster for freaks, geeks and international chess superstars.

ERDINGER WEIS BIER€4.00
 | 5.3% a.b.v. | Germany
 The World's most popular wheat beer. Bottle fermented like champagne, it is the definitive wheat beer.

BUDEJOVICKY BUDVAR€5.00
 | 5.0% a.b.v. | Czech Republic
 The heads of high quality Zatec hop, clear natural water & select Moravian barley make it the beverage of choice for true beer lovers. The 700 year old tradition and the unique 90-day period of maturity increase it's sublime character.

PILSNER URQUELL€4.50
 | 4.4% a.b.v. | Czech Republic
 Translated as 'Pilsner from the original source' Urquell is still brewed to the original recipe. The balance between the bitterness of the hops and the sweetness of the barley malt provides a full bodied flavour without the need for a high alcohol content.

O'HARA'S RED€5.00
 | 4.3% a.b.v.
 This Ale is full-bodied Irish red, ruby in colour, its fruity and aromatic with a distinctive hop character balanced with a generous blend of sweet malts and has a distinctive roast finish.

DUNCARVAN HEIVICK COLD BLONDE ALE ...€5.00
 | 4.9% a.b.v.
 This is a refreshing blonde ale generously hopped to give bitterness and aroma that packs a punch! There is a complexity at play here with a fruity aroma balanced by a hoppiness that makes it a slightly challenging but still quite easy to drink beer.

DUNCARVAN COPPER COAST RED€5.00
 | 4.3% a.b.v.
 This is a smooth, fruity ale with a definite caramel character created by the use of crystal malt in the brewing process but with an added hop balance that is not always present in red ales, and which balances the sweetness of the caramel flavours.

COMERACH CHALLENGER BITTER€5.00
 | 3.8% a.b.v.
 An English-style pale ale which is brewed using the naturally occurring hard water of West Waterford and hopped solely with Challenger hops to produce a traditional bitter. The malt profile and floral hops make for an elegant and understated ale.

PUNK IP€4.50
 | 5.6% a.b.v. | Fraserburgh, Scotland
 This fresh, full flavour natural beer is our tribute to the classic IPAs of yester-year. The post modern twist is the addition of amazing fruity hops giving an explosion of tropical fruit flavours and a sharp bitter finish.
